

SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS

At Mount Index International School, our students displayed outstanding talent and determination across a wide spectrum of individual and team sports during the academic session 2025–26.

Wushu: Our school's Wushu players brought immense pride by winning 2 gold and 2 silver medals at the Sub Junior National Trials, with one student also selected at the national level. At the Junior & Senior National Trials, 2 students secured silver medals. In SGFI tournaments, 4 students won gold medals at the division level and advanced to the state level.





Boxing: Young boxers showcased their fighting spirit at the SGFI U-14 & U-17 category, winning 2 first-place and 2 second-place positions.

Swimming: The school's swimmers made waves with 2 gold and 2 silver medals at the CBSE Cluster West Zone, and one student qualified for the CBSE Nationals. Additionally, one student was selected for the division level at SGFI trials.





Yoga: Our yoga practitioners balanced strength and focus, securing the winner's position at the Indore District Competition, and adding 1 silver and 2 bronze medals at the Krida Bharti Yog Competition.

Badminton: Students excelled at the 3rd HMG Trophy, emerging as winners. One student also secured selection at the division level in SGFI trials.





Cricket: The school's U-18 cricket team secured the Runner-Up position at the prestigious Indore Division Asha Bai Memorial Tournament.

Football: Our football teams represented the school at the Subroto Cup and Kasliwal Trophy. Two students were further selected for the division level at the SGFI trials.





Table Tennis: Students participated in CBSE Cluster and SGFI trials, with one student being selected for division-level matches.

Tennis: Our tennis players competed in the CBSE Cluster West Zone and SGFI Soft Tennis tournaments, proudly representing the school.

Skating, Chess, Kabaddi, Athletics & Kalaripayattu: Students took part with great zeal in SGFI and CBSE tournaments, gaining valuable experience and exposure at higher levels of competition.


